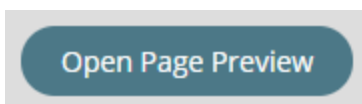
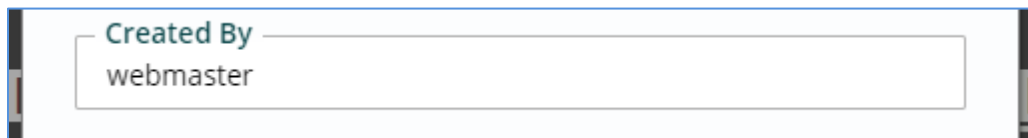
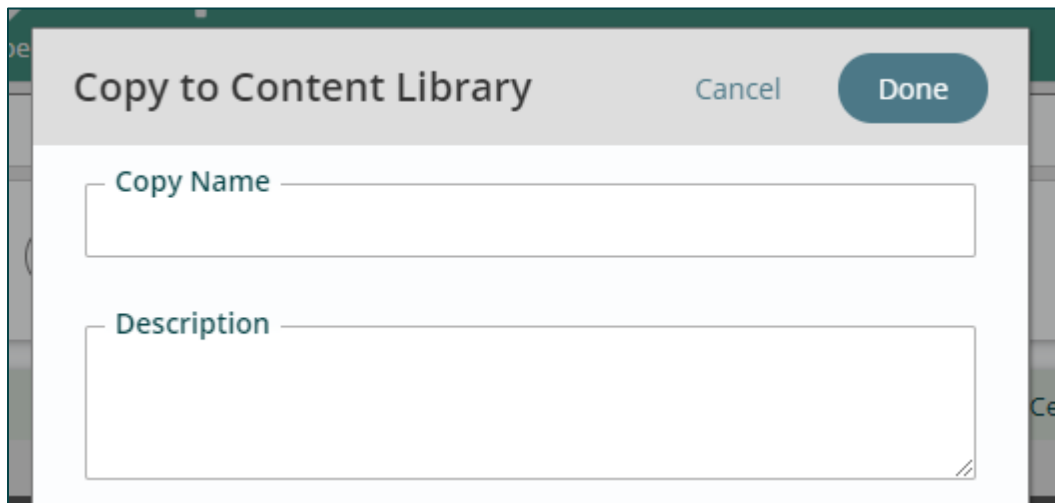
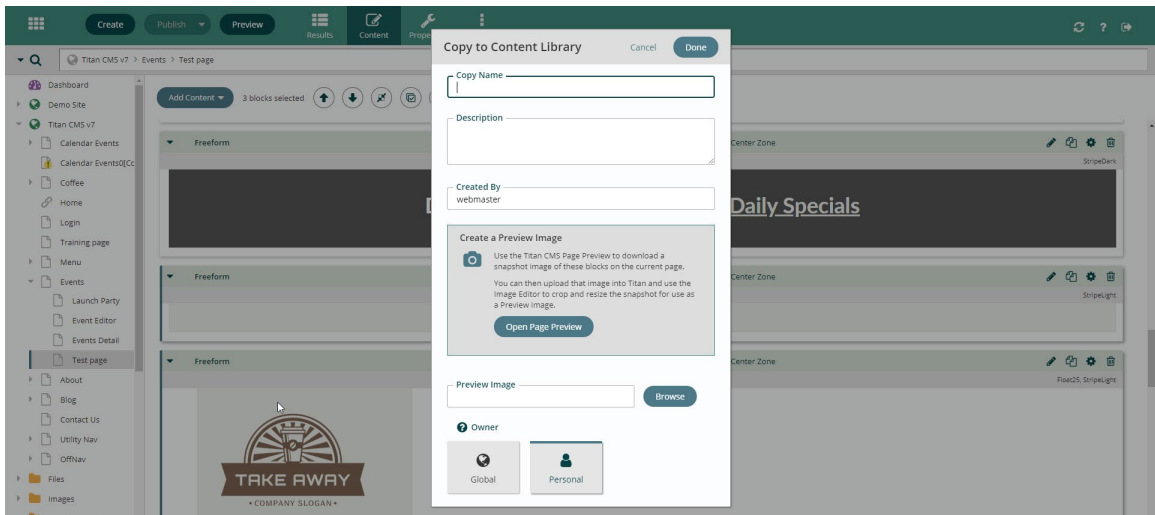
Titan CMS 7.2 brings the debut of a robust Content Library and additional content editing enhancements to the enterprise content management system.

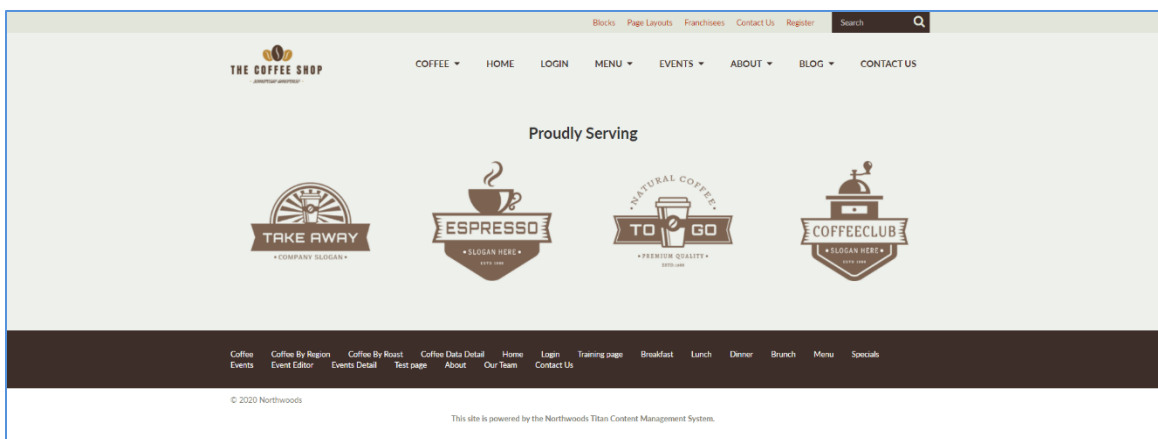
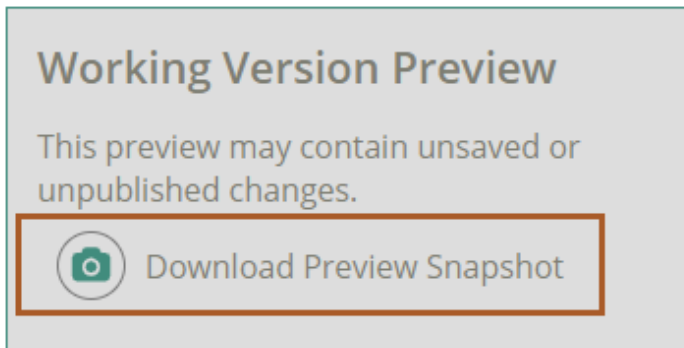
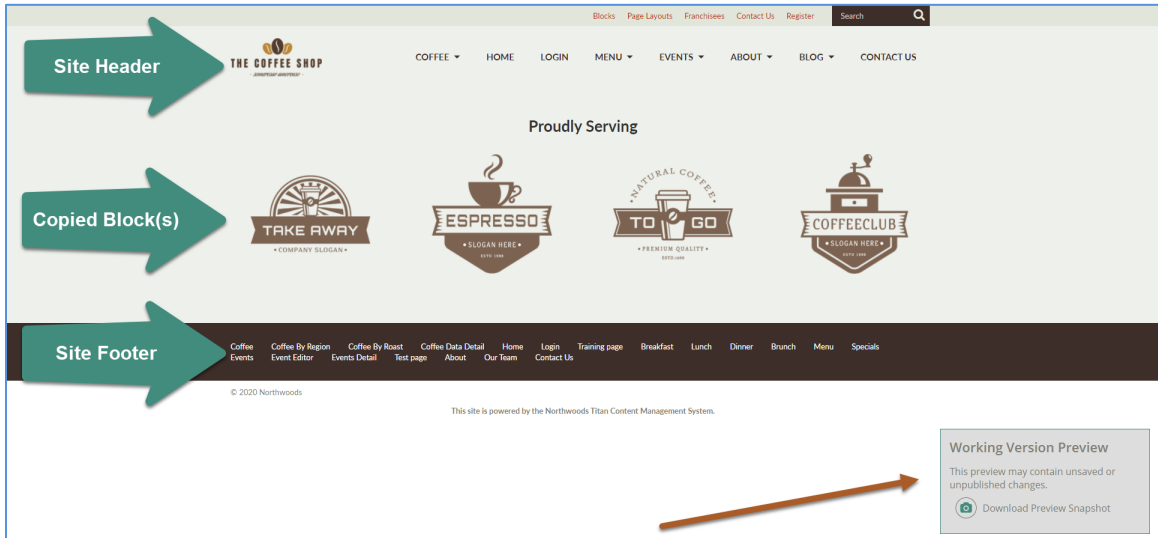
Features include the ability to add multiple blocks as content templates, select multiple blocks and edit styles or zones, and the ability to download a snapshot of an entire page in the preview dialog.

Add Block(s) to the Content Library

1. Open the page that contains the block(s) you want to add to your Content Library.

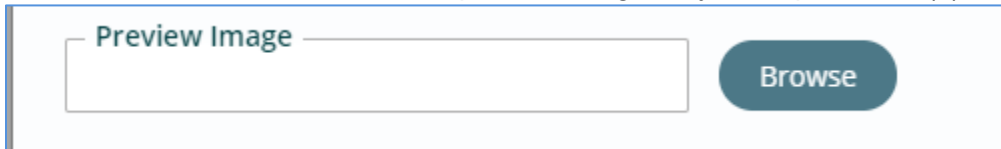




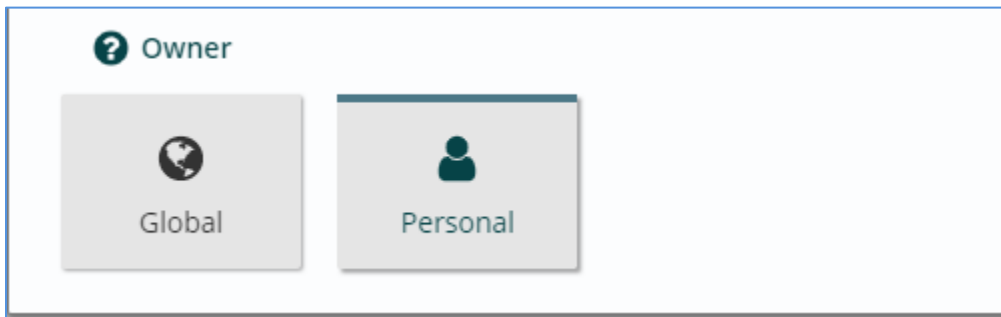


You can then upload this image into Titan and use the Image Editor to crop and resize the snapshot for use as a Preview Image.

11. Click the browse button to select a preview image for your copied block(s):



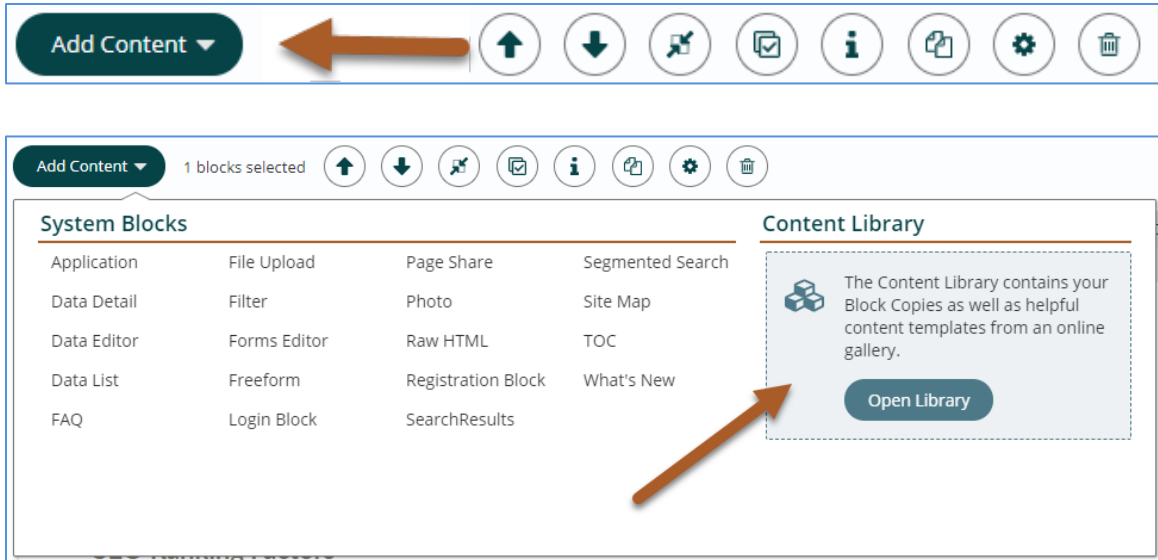
12. Use the content picker to select the image. Be sure to select the full-size image and not a smaller size.
13. Click **Done**.



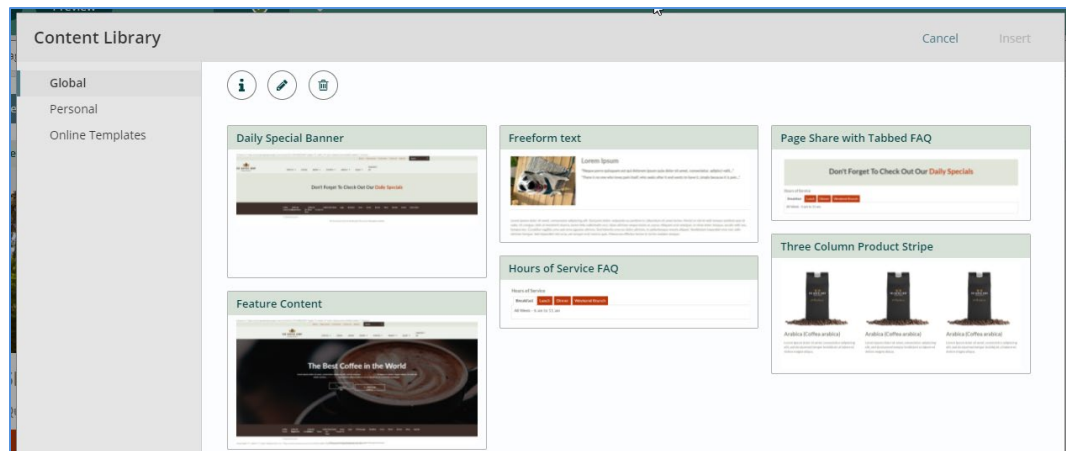

Block Action Buttons

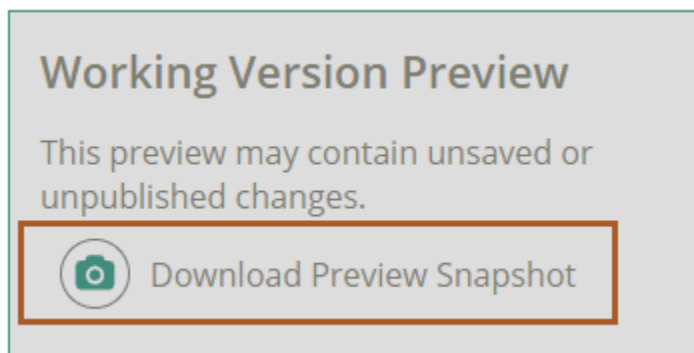
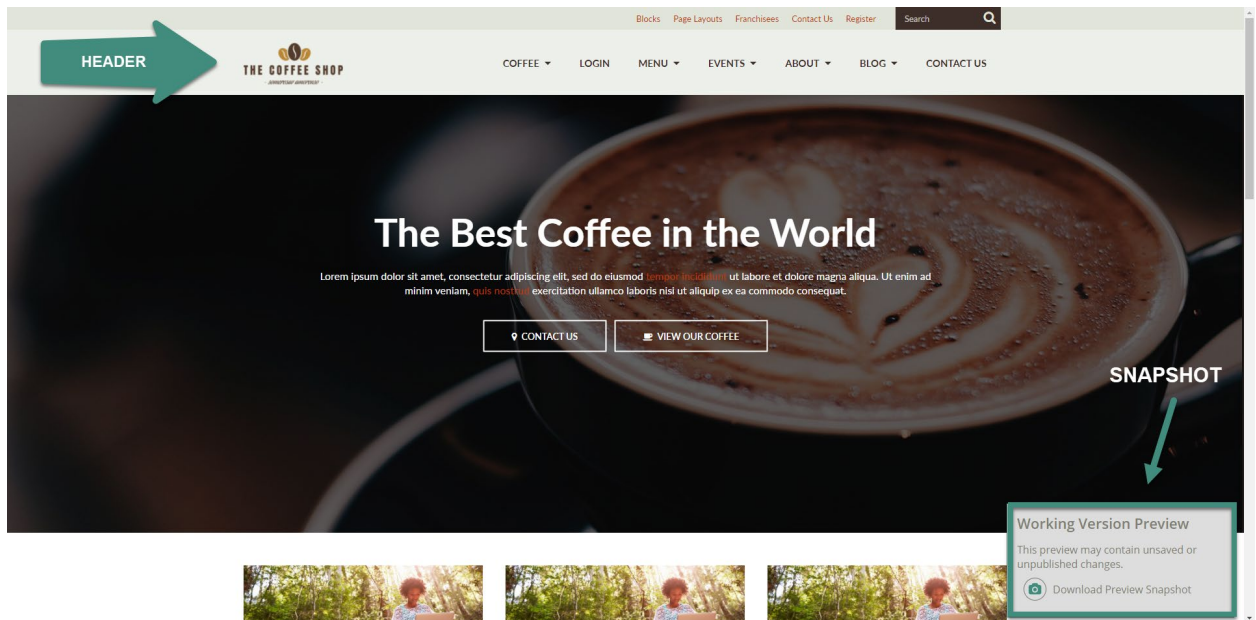
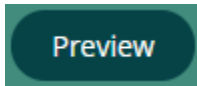


Block action buttons are buttons that allow you to take a variety of actions with a block or multiple blocks.

ICON	DESCRIPTION
	Select a block or multiple blocks and use the arrow buttons to move them vertically on your page.
	Use the collapse/expand button to collapse or expand all the blocks on the page.
	The select button will select all blocks on the page so that you can modify them all at the same time.
	The info button will display the block styles for all blocks on the page.
	Select a block or multiple blocks and click the copy button to add the selected block(s) to your content library.
	Select a block or multiple blocks and click the settings button to adjust block styles and zone selections.
	Select a block or multiple blocks and click the delete button to delete the selected block(s).
